- 6. Treasurer's Report

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 Do not have updated number from February currently. Budget was approved and we are well within the working budget. Looking to use the additional funds for the playground rehabilitation.

### 7. Open Discussion

- Q: Are there plans for an end of the year event for kindergarten?
- A: There has been a picnic the last couple of years for the students and their parents.

  There are no plans for a graduation event currently.
- Q: For new enrollment, are there any plans to change the timing of preschool to have it mirror the school day?
- A: Not currently because of the number of students and the size of campus and safety concerns.
- Q: Any considering having preschool students attend latchkey?
- A: Not currently due to licensing.
- Q: Is admission into preschool first come, first serve?
- A: Yes. In school families have priority, then it goes by first come first serve. Nursery school emails to go out in the next 1-2 days.
- Q: What is the number of kids enrolled currently at STL?
- A: 983 students currently. Capacity is 1065. Class sizes are kindergarten 25 students/class, first through third grade is 27 students/class and forth is 25 students/class currently with a max of 27 students/class. There are aides in the classroom up through third grade. Kindergarten has full times aides/class.
- O: Will all the kids fit in the auditorium?
- A: Yes. All the numbers above include preschool and nursery school. Those classes do not participate in assemblies, etc. in the auditorium.
- Q: Are parents allowed to attend mass on Wednesday?
- A: Only if the class is hosting. Never for all school mass.
- Q: Will they offer gym as a special all year for all classes?

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- A: Rotating schedules. There are 6 specials offered and only 5 days/week, so therefore
  there are more specials than days of the week. Looking at adding additional specials
  teachers next year. Specials teachers are hired through Avondale Community Schools.
  The state removed Media Center, which is while it was removed from the special
  offerings at STL. Specials currently include gym, art, music, health and Spanish.
- Q: Will it always be through Avondale?
- A: Avondale has the best working relationship with STL.
- Q: Has the financial reports been released from the Parish?
- A: Will get more information from the parish to answer this question.
- Q: Any other companies available for the book fair other than Scholastic?
- A: The librarian, Mrs. Thomas, has investigated multiple other different companies, but unfortunately they do not offer in person shopping options. The books were screened by parents prior to the fair. Only books that are appropriate for Catholic teaching will be available to purchase. Will continue to investigate other companies as that information becomes available.
